Advanced Course:

Brief Therapy with Hypnosis - Anxiety, Depression, PTSD

Program Objectives

Participants will: Observe and practice use of the tools of hypnoanalysis to diagnose and analyze the underlying causes of symptoms and learn the skills to successfully treat most Axis 1 disorders; participate in the unique processes of history-taking, word association, and dream analysis; observe demonstrations of age regressions and subconscious listening skills conducted with a volunteer client/patient from the Chicago area; participate in small group discussions. **At times during the Advanced Course, a second track will be offered for experienced clinicians currently using hypnoanalysis in their practices.**
